#### **DIRECTOR'S NOTE**

"And being found in appearance as a man, He humbled Himself, made Himself of no reputation and became obedient unto death—even the death of the cross." **Philippians 2:8** 

While most are familiar with the story of Jesus' death, only a few truly understand the passion, the heart, or the spirit behind it. For it is not merely a story but a telling of the truth of what the creator of the universe did for His creation.

Because indeed, "...at the name of Jesus, every knee will bow, in heaven and on earth, and every tongue confess that Jesus is Lord to the glory of God the Father." **Philippians 2:10-11**
